KwaZulu-Natal: Siyaya Coastal Park extends from the northern boundary of the Umlalazi Nature Reserve in the north, to the southern boundary of the Umthimkhulu Nature Reserve in the south. The boundaries of the RUA and access points must be clearly demarcated. The boundaries of the RUA are Umlazi Estuary in the north, and the Umlazi North Ramp in the south.
